6) Safe Disposal of Hazardous Laser-Associated Waste and Transfer of Laser Ownership

The applicable portions of Part I - Chapter 6 shall be followed by all personnel/students/visitors in the handling & disposal of lasers and laser-associated ted waste. The conditions and requirements of this chapter are in addition to applicable portions of Part I - Chapter 6. The generator (lab, researcher, unit) is responsible for ensuring that all laser associated waste is disposed of in a manner that minimizes the risk to health, safety, and the environment and in accordance with the KU Hazardous Materials/Waste Management Manual. All lasers must be transferred or disposed under the authority of the EHS Laser Safety Officer.
